Eligibility Criteria for The Lawrence School Bursary Scheme 2019-20

1. Academic performance of the child should be above 60%.
2. Annual income (Gross Salary) of parents should be less than Rs15 lakhs per annum. In case of more than one child, gross salary should be less than Rs 20 lakhs per annum.
3. Proposed number of Bursaries:

For Classes 5th and 6th – 2 students

Classes 7th and 8th – 2 students

Classes 9th and 10th – 2 students

Classes 11th and 12th – 2 students

The bursary amount will be 25% - 50% of the School fee.

Last date for application is 5th April, 2019.

4. Duration of the Bursary – One Academic year (*Continuation of the Bursary for the next year is not guaranteed*).
5. The decision of the committee will be final and the School will not entertain any further appeal pertaining to the same.
