Photo Memories & Mini-Story

Step 2: Give Each Photo a Title. Create a short, catchy title for every photo. Examples:

- "The Giant Ice Cream Disaster"
- "Sunset at the Rooftop"
- "My Partner in Crime"

Step 3: Add a Caption. Write one sentence below each photo explaining what is happening or how you felt.

Example:

"This was the moment I realised climbing rocks isn't as easy as it looks."

Step 4: Write a Short Narrative (100–120 words). Use all five photos to create:

- One connected mini-story, OR
- A diary-style holiday entry

Step 5: Put It All Together. Present your work as a mini booklet.

Character Therapy Session!

Task:

Imagine **any one character** from the Class IX English lessons goes to a **therapist or counsellor**. Your job is to write a script of the therapy session.

What you must include:

1. A short introduction

• Why the character needs therapy (fear, guilt, loneliness, a mistake they made, a loss they suffered, anger issues, conflict with another character).

2. A dialogue format

- o Therapist (T): ...
- o Character (C): ...

3. What the character talks about

You may include:

- o Their biggest fear
- o A major event that hurt or confused them
- Something they regret
- o Someone they miss
- o A difficult choice they had to make

4. What the therapist helps them understand

- o Their emotions
- o Their motivations
- What they could have done differently
- How they can heal/grow forward

5. Ending

- o Write how the character feels after the session.
- o Example: "The character leaves the room calmer, more confident, or hopeful."

"Dear Author" Letter

Task:

Write a **personal letter to** the **author or poet** of any one chapter or poem from the Grade 9 English textbook. Imagine you could send this letter directly to them. **Your letter should include:**

A. Opening (2–3 lines)

- Introduce yourself
- Mention the lesson/poem you read
- Share one sentence about why you chose it

B. Body Paragraphs

You may include **any 3–4** of the following:

1. A scene that touched you or stayed with you

Explain why — was it moving, funny, shocking, relatable?

2. A character you admire or dislike

What did they teach you? What confused you? What frustrated you?

3. Questions you want to ask the author

- o Why did you choose this ending?
- Why did this character behave like this?
- o Was this scene inspired by real life?
- o What message did you want readers to take away?

4. How the lesson/poem changed your thinking

- o Did it make you kinder, braver, more aware?
- o Did it remind you of a real-life situation?

5. Suggestions for the author

- o A character you wished had a bigger role
- o A twist you imagined
- o An alternate ending you would love to see

C. Closing (2–3 lines)

- Thank the author
- Share if you'd like to read more of their work
- A polite farewell

Topic: To compare crops grown in Tamilnadu & West Bengal

Project Outline:

1 Introduction:

- Briefly explaining about Agriculture, crop, different types of crops, conditions required, food security, Kharif & Rabi crops, major groups of activities for improving crop yields
- Introduce both Tamil Nadu and West Bengal as states with unique characteristics in terms of geography, economy and food requirements.
- State the purpose of the project: To compare how these states produce different crops, their sources of irrigation and their efficiency in managing population demands

2 Data Required & Analysis:

- State-wise area, production & yield (annual) by crop,
- Kharif/Rabi season coverage reports, Rainfall data, irrigation area stats
- Challenges & opportunities in both the states, Area share by crop (% of gross cropped area). Contribution to state foodgrain, Irrigated area share.

Comparative study:

- State-wise area, production & yield (annual) by crop, Rainfall data, irrigation area stats, Area share by crop (% of gross cropped area). Contribution to state foodgrain, Irrigated area share
- 3. Scientific data representation:
 - Create Bar graphs, Pie charts, Line graphs
- 4. Artistic representation:
 - Creative Art:
 - Students can draw a map of India, highlighting Tamil Nadu and West Bengal, with symbols or icons

5. Impact Analysis:

- Discuss how the differences in food production impact the local population in terms of availability, cost and environmental quality.
- News & policy releases for recent interventions (e.g., irrigation schemes, cold-storage, procurement)
- Focus on government initiatives like subsidies, policies and projects aimed at promoting sustainable livelihood

6. Conclusion:

- Sum up the findings of the comparative study
- Suggest recommendations for improving food/ crop production efficiency in both states
- Encourage the promotion of organic farming

7. Bibliography:

• List of books, articles, web sites and data sources used to gather information for the project.

FOREST SOCIETY AND COLONIALISM

General Instructions:

- 1. Prepare a detailed handwritten project on any one of the topics given below.
- 2. Do some basic research using your textbook and other resources (Chapter Forest society and colonialism).
- 3. The project should contain the following:
 - a) Introduction
 - b) A brief description of all the sub-topics mentioned in the topic
 - c) Conclusion
 - d) Bibliography: List the books or websites you used to find your information.
- 4. You must use collages, posters, maps, charts, diagrams, pictures and postcards to supplement your research.
- 5. You are requested to attempt any one of the topics given below.

TOPIC I

"The Nilgiris Under British Rule: How Did Colonialism Change the Land, People, and Environment?"

In this project, you will research and discuss the following sub-topics:

- The Nilgiris Before British Rule: What was life like in the Nilgiris before the British came? Research and create a picture collage or drawing showing the native people and forests.
- The British takeover: How did the British change the Nilgiris? Look at how they introduced plantations (tea and coffee), built railways, and made new forest laws. You can make a poster or illustration to show these changes.
- The Impact of Invasive Plants: The British brought new plants like eucalyptus to the Nilgiris. How did these plants affect the environment? Create a before-and-after picture of the land with native plants versus new plants.
- **How Did Local People React?** How did the **Toda** and other tribal communities feel about these changes? Were they forced off their land?
- **The Environmental Impact**: How did the changes made by the British hurt or help the local environment? Draw a simple **chart or diagram** showing how the land changed after the British arrived.
- The Legacy of Colonialism: Do you still see signs of British influence in the Nilgiris today? You can make a "postcard" showing the Nilgiris now and compare it with how it was during British rule.

TOPIC II

"The Decline of the forest cover in the Indian subcontinent between 1880 and 1920"

Between 1880 and 1920, forest cover in the Indian subcontinent declined by 9.7 million hectares, from 108.6 million hectares to 98.9 million hectares. In this project, you will discuss the role of the following factors in this decline using appropriate examples of each:

- Railways
- Shipbuilding
- Agricultural Expansion
- Commercial Farming
- Tea/Coffee plantations
- Adivasi and other peasant users
