Dear Parents,

We are happy to inform you that all students of class XI will attend an Outbound Learning (OBL) adventure trip to the Himalayas from the 5th to the 12th of February, 2018 after the completion of their Annual Assessment. The School has made all arrangements for this unique, high energy, deeply impacting and experiential learning programme.

The itinerary in brief includes snow treks to Chopta, Deoriatal and Chandrashila peak and river rafting from Jayalgarh to Devprayag on the River Alaknanda. Students will journey by road along the River Ganga and Alaknanda before turning into the Mandakini valley. Enroute they will cross the towns of Haridwar, Rishikesh, Devprayag and Rudraprayag. They will travel by air between Coimbatore and Delhi. The approximate cost of the OBL trip is Rs. 34,000 plus personal expenses which may amount to a maximum of Rs. 39,000/-.

This OBL trip is an extraordinary student engagement program which will unlock potential talents and strengths of each student. The natural environment and outdoor activities add to the thrill and fun in adventure, helps in acceptance and participation, in openness to risk taking, moving out of comfort zones, experimentation, receiving feedback and adapting to change in behaviour. The adventure and exercises promote self discovery and powerful insight into personal behaviour and living styles.

If we do not hear from you by this date, we shall consider that we have your approval for the trip. The clothing list is also attached.
