
Rational Numbers

1. Sum of two numbers is $\frac{3}{4}$, one of the number is $\frac{1}{8}$. Find the other number.
2. What number should be multiplied with $\frac{1}{4}$ so as to get the product as $\frac{-5}{16}$?
3. Simplify $\left\{\frac{6}{7} + \frac{3}{8} - \frac{1}{2}\right\} \times \frac{4}{3}$ and find its reciprocal.
4. Use appropriate property and find $\frac{-1}{6} \times \frac{4}{7} + \frac{1}{2} - \frac{3}{7} \times \frac{1}{6}$
5. If $a = \frac{1}{2}$, $b = \frac{-3}{4}$, verify the following:
 - (i) $a \times b = b \times a$
 - (ii) $a + b = b + a$
6. Let O, P and Z represent the numbers 0, 3 and -5 respectively on the number line. Points Q, R and S are between O and P such that $OQ = QR = RS = SP$. 4. Make a Landscape painting by using watercolor, postercolour, acrylic colour, pencil colour or crayon on drawing paper.




















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
