### ***General Instructions:***

- 1- Prepare a neat and handwritten project on any one of the topics given below.
- 2- The students can use their own discretion to do the assignment either on chart paper or scrap book papers or hand drawn map on chart paper in accordance to the assignment chosen.
- 3- Map can be pasted on the chart paper or scrap book.
- 4- The assignment has to be well decorated and presented properly.
- 5- Students can use any type of colours except for pastel or wax colours.

### ***Project Topic (any one)***

- a- Prepare a neat project on "Unity in Diversity" means (e.g., oneness despite differences). Pictures of festivals, food, dresses etc can be used for pasting. Highlight different cultures, languages, religions, and traditions. Explore and write how mutual respect and constitutional values bind people together. You can do the project either on the chart paper or scrap book.
- b- Create an informative chart distinguishing between archaeological sources (artifacts), literary sources (manuscripts) and Inscriptions. You can also draw and color replicas of ancient coins.
- c- Create a fictional "Treasure Map" of a city or your school. You can also draw a grid over it, and write down 3-4 "clues" using coordinates (e.g., "The treasure is located exactly where – North/South/East/West)
- d- On the world map, mark the continents and oceans and paste the map on the scrap book. Write a short note on how continents and oceans originated. You can either write and paste the whole assignment on scrap book or do it on one whole big chart paper.
