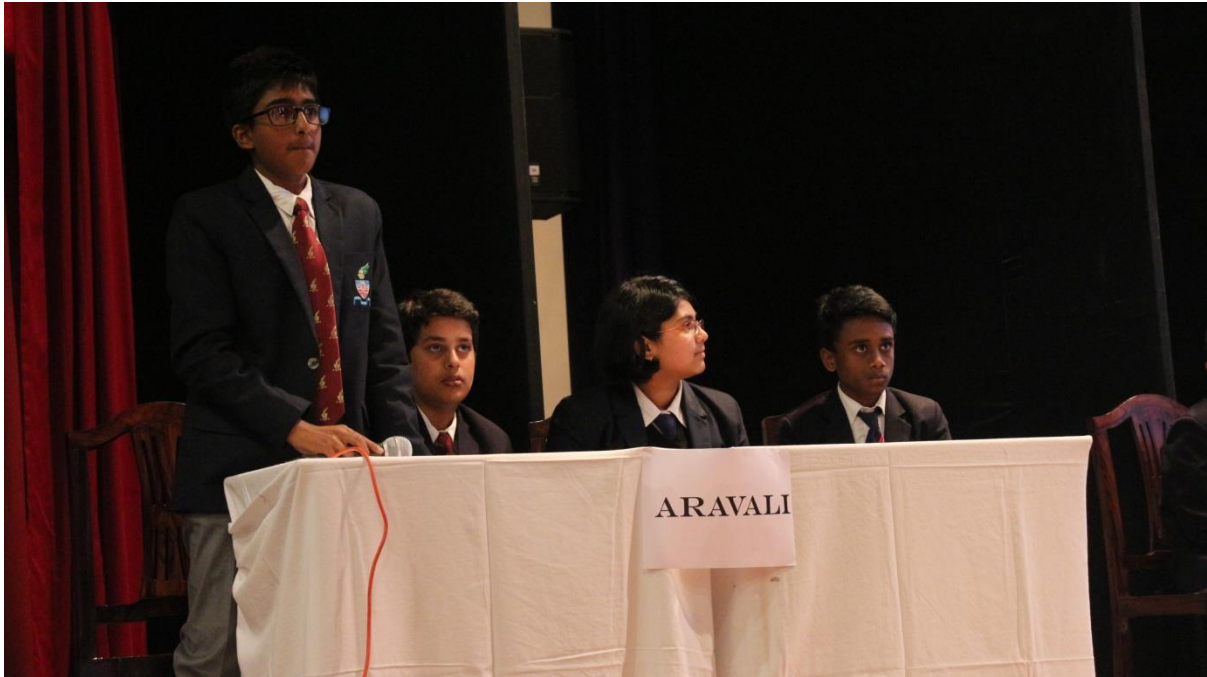


## **A report about “DIGI QUIZ 2016”**

There were four enthusiastic young minds participating from each house.



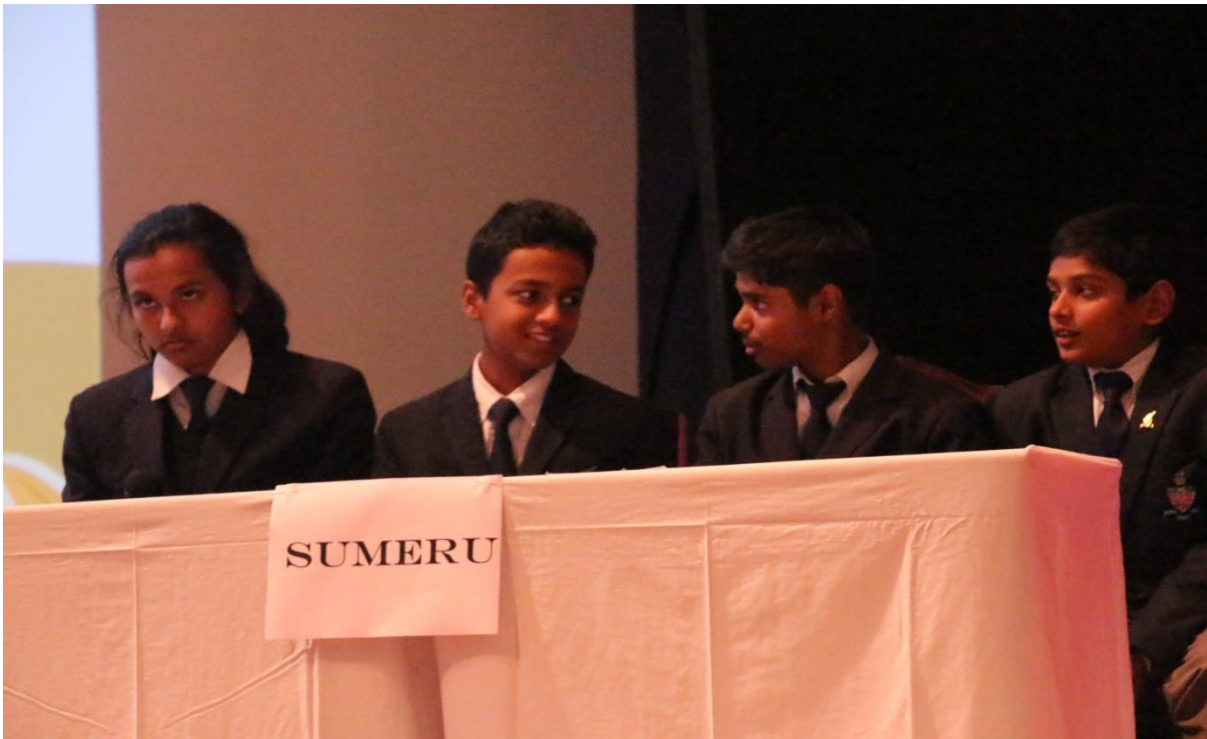
