**Description:** Prepare a speech on ONE of the topics given below for 2 to 2 ½ minutes.

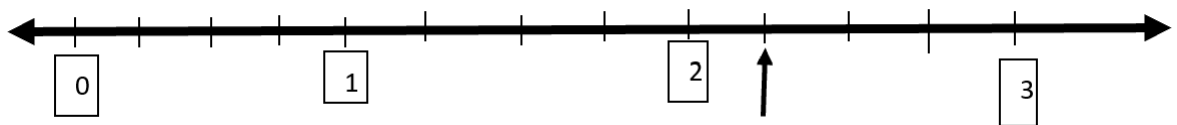

## SCIENCE

### Instructions:

### **Objective- Students will:**

- Understand different seasons in India

- Develop observation, creativity, presentation, and research skills.

## **ART INTEGRATED PROJECT**

### **A. Summer Season**

### **B. Rainy/Monsoon Season**

Art Activity- Paint a scene with clouds, umbrellas, puddles, frog.

A small write-up on what you like to do on a rainy day.

### **C. Winter Season**

Art Activity- Draw pictures related to winter season- Snowman (creative), sweaters, bonfire.

A small write-up about the season.

#### **D. Spring Season**

Art activity- Draw pictures related to season like - flowers, butterflies, and green leaves

A write-up on the season.

## **SOCIAL SCIENCE**

### **General Instructions:**

- 1- Prepare a neat and handwritten project on any one of the topics given below.
- 2- The students can use their own discretion to do the assignment either on chart paper or scrap book papers or hand drawn map on chart paper in accordance to the assignment chosen.
- 3- Map can be pasted on the chart paper or scrap book.
- 4- The assignment has to be well decorated and presented properly.
- 5- Students can use any type of colours except for pastel or wax colours.

### **6- Assignment (any one)**

- a. Design a travel brochure for a unique place you learned about, such as the Andaman and Nicobar Islands, a mangrove forest, Sikkim or Loktak Lake of Manipur. Include an eye-catching title, a map, images of unique plants and animals, a description of its special features and a section on why it's important to protect.
- b. Create a protection plan for an animal featured in the chapter, like the Royal Bengal Tiger or Andaman hornbill. Your plan should include steps for protecting its habitat (e.g., planting trees), providing food and water and educating others. For this assignment, you can either make pamphlets from scrap book or make attractive poster, depicting the points mentioned above.
- c. Use a map to locate different unique places and their features such as Indira point being the southernmost tip of India or the western Ghats being a biodiversity hotspot. Research and mark the location of at least five unique places on the outline map of India. Add labels with key features and facts for each place.

Find out a unique place in your own locality or state, which could be a local historical site, a unique building or a natural area. Write about its history, why it's unique and its significance to the community. For this assignment, you can write your report on A4 sheet paper and paste it on the scrap book. Use creativity to make your report attractive.

## FRENCH

### French Holiday Homework – Class 5, Dec-Jan 2025-26

For the holiday homework, the class will be divided into 5 groups. Each group will create a set of handmade French flashcards on a specific theme. These flashcards must be designed creatively, using drawings/colours, and must include English meanings for every French word. No AI tools (such as ChatGPT) should be used – everything must be done by hand.

#### Group-wise Flashcard Tasks

- Group 1: Professions – Include both masculine and feminine forms using indefinite articles. (un/une). Add drawings, be as creative as you'd like!
- Group 2: Numbers (0–50) – Write the number in French and English (at the bottom). Add number-based visual designs - the 1 can be a squiggly line or anything you want it to be!
- Group 3: Colours – Use coloured flashcards and include English meanings and examples wherever possible. Try to draw animals or a rainbow or anything you want for each colour!
- Group 4: Days of the Week – Add drawings representing each day (e.g., school, weekend). Include English meanings.
- Group 5: Months of the Year – Add seasonal drawings. Include English meanings. Extra points for adding seasons as well!

#### Instructions

1. All flashcards must be hand-drawn and handwritten.
2. Each flashcard must include: the French word, its English meaning, and a relevant drawing.
3. Use colours and creativity – this is an art-integrated activity.
4. Submit your flashcards neatly arranged in an envelope with your group name.
