Greetings from Lovedale!

We hope that your child/children are having a pleasant winter vacation and you have been able to spend quality time with them.

We are most certain that students of Classes X and XII would have returned to their preparations for the Board Examinations, after an initial short break. Your support and motivation for children at home is highly appreciated. It will help them stay focussed and work hard.

As we joyfully step into 2018 today, we are also eagerly awaiting our Class X, XI and XII students on Sunday, 7.1.2018 and the rest of the school on Sunday, 21.1.2018. The two additional weeks that the Senior School children get will be utilised effectively for structured and focussed revisions, trial examinations, and preparations towards the impending Board Exams for Classes X and XII. Teachers of Class XI will use these two weeks for course completion and to prepare students for their Annual Examination scheduled to begin on 27th January 2018. While the children were away in December, the School Administration began the race-against-time operation to take care of the repair and maintenance requirements across the School. Most of the tasks that were taken up have been completed and the facilities are ready
